



Mebane, NC Community Profile



Located near the border of Alamance and Orange Counties, the City of Mebane traces its beginnings to the early 19th century when a post office was established in 1809. The town was named for Brigadier General Alexander Mebane of the North Carolina Militia and a member of Congress in the 1790s. The railroad arrived in 1855 and Mebanesville was incorporated in 1881. The name was officially changed to Mebane in 1883. One of the fastest growing areas in North Carolina, Mebane is focused on preserving its rich history and traditions while welcoming many new businesses, homes and residents. Mebane also enjoys a growing reputation for its beautiful golf courses.
